1. Download the necessary files

Download necessary files to prepare for flashing MIUI ROM

Note:

1. This tutorial is intended to be performed using the Windows operating system environment.
2. This tutorial is only for Meizu MX2
3. Please be careful when flashing the ROM. Xiaomi Corporation does not take any responsibility for any problem caused by flashing.
4. This tutorial is from an Internet resource and has been reorganized officially. If there are any copyright issues please contact the administrator. For more detailed information, please refer to disclaimer.

Step 1:

Download the latest [MIUI ROM for MEIZU MX2](#) installation package. If you have downloaded the latest installation pack, there will be no need to download it again. Notice a OTA update should always be installed on top of a full ROM.

Step 2:

Download [Flyme 2.2](#) and [MIUI Recovery](#). After the download is complete, copy the update.bin or update.zip to the internal storage of the phone.

Step 3:

Make sure that you have more than 2GB free space on the phone's internal storage. Don't unzip MIUI ROM installation package, copy it into the root directory of the phone's internal storage.

2. Restore to the official Flyme 2.2 system

Preparation: Restore of the official system and phone system privileges.

Note:

Make sure your phone is fully charged, this step will clear all user data and may void the warranty. Please make a backup. If you already have the Flyme 2.2 system, you can skip this step.

Step 1:

Perform following actions using your phone


Turn of the phone, and press and hold the volume up + power button simultaneously to enter the official flash mode. Put a tick (v) next to System upgrade and Clear data and then press Start. The phone will restart automatically when finished.



Step 2:

Perform following actions using your phone

Login you Flyme account, then go to Settings --> Accounts --> More... and open System Privileges. The phone will automatically reboot after filling in password in confirmation screen.



3. Installing Recovery

Install MIUI Recovery so you can successfully install MIUI ROM

Note:

Make sure you have successfully opened System Privileges

Step 1:

Perform following actions using your phone

Go to Settings --> Accessibility --> Developer options and enable USB debugging. Then connect your phone to the computer.

Step 2:


Perform following actions using the computer

Copy RecoveryInstaller.apk to your phone's internal storage.

Step 3:

Perform following actions using your phone

Install RecoveryInstaller.apk, then open and then choose Install. If a confirmation prompt is shown click on OK. Then click on Boot to recovery and the phone will automatically restart.



4. Installing the MIUI ROM

Installing the MIUI ROM

Step 1:

Perform following actions using your phone

Make sure that your phone has entered the MIUI Recovery interface (use the power button to confirm and the volume keys to select). Now choose English --> Wipe or format --> Factory reset --> Yes. If operation done, use the power button to return to the Main menu.



Step 2:

Perform following actions using your phone

Choose Install from SD --> Choose ZIP from SD --> miui-mx2-xxxxx.zip --> Yes. The installation process takes about 10 minutes. If the screen dims, tap on the screen to undim, this is normal behaviour. If

operation done, use the power button to return to the Main menu. Now choose Power menu --> Reboot --> Yes. Wait for the reboot to complete, and you can start experiencing MIUI.
