1. [Download Odin v3.13.1](#)
2. Extract the firmware file you just downloaded. You should get 5 files:  
AP (System & Recovery)  
BL (Bootloader)  
CP (Modem / Radio)  
CSC\_\*\*\* (Country / Region / Operator)  
HOME\_CSC\_\*\*\* (Country / Region / Operator)
3. Add each file to its respective field in Odin v3.13.1. Use CSC\_\*\*\* if you want to do a clean flash or HOME\_CSC\_\*\*\* if you want to keep your apps and data.
4. Reboot your phone in Download / Odin mode (make sure your device is off) with the following button combo: POWER + VOLUME DOWN + BIXBY  
Other options in case first option did not work or isn't possible.  
Option 2 VOLUME DOWN + VOLUME UP then USB cable  
Option 3 POWER + VOLUME DOWN + VOLUME UP  
Option 4 POWER + VOLUME DOWN + HOME BUTTON  
Option 5 (Note9) USB cable + VOLUME DOWN + BIXBY
5. Once in download mode, connect your phone to the PC, preferably using the original USB cable you got with your phone. Odin should detect your device and a BLUE box will show up with the COM port number. (Be sure, the SAMSUNG-drivers are installed on your PC!)
